The undersigned, being all of the members of the Board of Directors of Forward Foods LLC, a Delaware limited liability company (the "Company"), pursuant to Section 18-302(d) of the Delaware Limited Liability Company Act, do hereby waive notice and dispense with a meeting and hereby adopt the following resolutions by unanimous written consent:

RESOLVED, that the Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to (i) file a voluntary petition for reorganization pursuant to chapter 11 of Title 11 (the "Bankruptcy Code") of the United States Code, (ii) to file such voluntary petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware and (iii) perform any and all such acts as are reasonable, advisable, expedient, convenient, proper or necessary to effect any of the foregoing; and it is further

RESOLVED, that, subject to the immediately foregoing resolution, the Chief Executive Officer or the Chief Financial Officer of the Company (each, an "Officer" and collectively, the "Officers"), shall be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and empowered to execute and deliver or cause to be filed, on behalf of the Company, (i) the voluntary petition of the Company pursuant to chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code and (ii) any and all other documents necessary or appropriate in connection therewith in such form or forms as the Officer or Officers so acting may approve; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Company, as debtor and debtor in possession under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code, may negotiate and enter into such debtor in possession financing agreements with the Company's lenders and/or certain of its customers, in connection therewith, may borrow funds from such parties in such amounts and on such terms as may be deemed by the Officer or any Officers as reasonably necessary for the continuing conduct of the affairs of the Company and may grant security interests in or liens upon all or substantially all of the Company's assets as may be deemed necessary by such Officer or Officers in connection with such borrowings; and it is further

RESOLVED, that any Officer shall be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to execute and deliver for and on behalf of the Company, either as debtor or debtor in possession under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code or prior to commencement of any such case, such agreements, instruments, and any and all other documents necessary or appropriate to facilitate the transactions contemplated by the immediately foregoing resolution (the "Financing Documents") and that the Financing Documents containing such provisions, terms conditions, covenants, warranties and representations as may be deemed necessary or appropriate by such Officer hereby are approved; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the law firm of Benesch, Friedlander, Coplan & Aronoff LLP ("BFC&A") shall be, and it hereby is, authorized and empowered to represent the Company, as debtor and debtor in possession, to render services as bankruptcy reorganization counsel in connection with the chapter 11 case and any other related matters in connection therewith; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Officers or any Officer shall be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to retain BFC&A and pay BFC&A a further retainer in the amount of \$75,000.00 as is contemplated by the immediately foregoing resolution; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Officers or any Officer shall be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and empowered to retain on behalf of the Company, such other attorneys, financial advisors, investment bankers, accountants, and other professionals as the Officer or Officers shall deem appropriate in his or their judgment; and it is further

RESOLVED, that the Officers or any Officer shall be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and empowered to take or cause to be taken any and all such further action, to execute and deliver any and all such further instruments and documents and to pay all such fees and expenses, as the Officer so acting shall deem appropriate in his or their judgment to fully carry out the intent and accomplish the purposes of these resolutions; and it is further

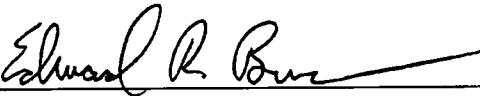
