
ORDER GRANTING PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

This matter having come on for hearing upon the Ex Parte Application of Plaintiff Lloyds Bank, plc, f/k/a Lloyds TSB Bank plc, in its capacity as Facility Agent for (I) Issuance of Temporary Restraining Order and (II) Order of Notice for Hearing on Preliminary Injunction and the Affidavit of Andrew Moore, and notice and an opportunity to be heard having been given to the Defendant, and upon hearing the Court having found that (1) there is a likelihood that the Plaintiff will succeed on the merits of its claims and (2) that the Plaintiff will suffer irreparable harm without the injunction it has requested, and (3) that in light of the Plaintiff's likelihood of success, the risk of

irreparable harm to the Plaintiff if the injunction is not granted outweighs the potential harm to the Defendant if enjoined,

IT IS ORDERED that until further order of this Court, the Defendant Service Point USA, Inc., and each and all of its employees, servants, representatives, agents, attorneys, and any person or entity acting for or on its behalf is enjoined from

directly or indirectly (a) transferring, assigning, encumbering, mortgaging, pledging, or otherwise alienating any property of Service Point USA, Inc. ("SPU"), wherever located, (b) exercising, or attempting to exercise dominion or control over any property of SPU, wherever located, (c) interfering with the contracts and/or the accounts of SPU, wherever located, (d) exercising, or attempting to exercise dominion and control over the U.S. mails addressed to SPU, and/or the business records and tangible and intangible assets of SPU, and (e) to immediately assemble and deliver to the Agent, or to any receiver appointed in this civil action, all of the U.S. mail addressed to SPU, together with all keys for any post office boxes of SPU, and all of the business records and tangible and intangible assets of SPU;
