**UNITED STATES TRUSTEE'S LIMITED OBJECTION  
TO MOTION OF DEBTORS-IN-POSSESSION FOR ORDER AUTHORIZING (A)  
MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN OF THE DEBTORS' EXISTING BANK ACCOUNTS,  
AND BUSINESS FORMS AND (B) RELATED RELIEF  
(DOCKET NO. 11)  
(WITH CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE)**

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 586(a)(3) and 11 U.S.C. § 307, the United States Trustee submits this limited objection to the motion of Debtors-In-Possession for order authorizing maintenance of certain of the Debtors' existing bank accounts and business forms and related relief ("Motion") filed by SW Boston Hotel Venture LLC, General Trading Company, Frank Sawyer Corporation, 100 Stuart Street LLC, and Auto Sales & Service, Inc. ("Debtors") as follows:

1. The United States Trustee does not object to the Motion, provided that the Debtors supplement their OIRR obligations by: i) as to each account described in the Motion and any subsequently opened accounts at an Authorized Depository (“Debtors’ Accounts”), providing the United States Trustee with copies of signature cards for each account described in the Motion as well as all monthly bank account statements; ii) evidencing a clear break in check sequence in the Debtors’ Accounts following the petition date; iii) stamping “Debtor In Possession” on all checks issued from the Debtors’ Accounts; iv) accounting in monthly operating reports for all transactions and transfers to/from non-debtor entities and between and among the Debtor Accounts; v) accounting in monthly operating reports for all inter-company transactions and transfers, including post-petition inter-company balances on each account described in the Motion; vi) listing, by account number, in monthly operating reports all month end book balances for each account described in the Motion, with an attestation that each account has been reconciled; vii) providing in monthly operating reports itemized disbursement information by account; viii) providing the United States Trustee with the Debtors’ most recent consolidated Federal tax return; ix) providing the United States Trustee with the most recent 941 quarterly payroll returns; and x) providing the United States Trustee with a chart of all accounts.

Notwithstanding the requests set forth above, the United States Trustee reserves his right to object to the proposed extension of time to comply with the requirements of 11 U.S.C. 345(b) pending receipt of further information regarding the accounts described in the Motion.
