**NOTICE DIRECTING ATTORNEY Alan C. Shafner TO COMPLY WITH  
U.S. DISTRICT COURT RULE 204: ADMISSION OF COUNSEL PRO HAC VICE**

Local Bankruptcy Rule 9010-1 adopts and makes applicable in this Court Local Rule 204 of the U.S. District Court for the District of Rhode Island governing procedures for admission Pro Hac Vice in this Court. Rule 204 of the U.S. District Court, requires that all attorneys who are not members of the federal bar of this district file:

(1) a Motion for Admission Pro Hac Vice together with the attorney certification for pro hac vice admission, substantially similar in form to the R.I. Bankr. Form T; and

(2) a check made payable to the Bar Fund in the amount of \$50.00.

If compensation will be sought from the bankruptcy estate, the unadmitted attorney and local counsel must both file Applications to be Employed, together with Affidavits of Disinterestedness.

Failure to comply with LBR 9010-1 within fourteen (14) days of this notice will result in the striking of the underlying document that was filed by the unadmitted attorney.
